Learn to Skate

Introduces children to the basic fundamentals of skating in a 6-stage program. The skater is taught by certified Program Assistants and NCCP certified Professional coaches, in a fun-filled atmosphere including games and group lessons with a:

Student to Instructor ratio at 6-1.

The program consists of a 15-minute warm up followed by a 30-minute group lesson (15 minutes with a Professional Coach and 15 minutes with a Program Assistant.) Following the group lesson is a 10-minute cool down.

Learn to Skate

Advanced

This program is designed for the figure skater that has successfully passed the Learn to Skate program. This program offers opportunities for skaters to develop basic to advanced skating skills in four different areas: Interpretive, Dance, Free Skating and Skating Skills.

Advanced 1: Must have completed Stage 6 in Learn to Skate
Advanced 2: Completed Preliminary Freeskate/Jr, Bronze Dances

Advanced 2:	Sunday	3:00 – 4:30 pm

Guest Skating fee \$25.00. Maximum 3 sessions per season.

All session will be limited to 22 skaters filled on first come basis.

Dear Parent,

Next to buying the best safety equipment, the BEST tool is to prepare your children to learn how to skate. Many young individuals that are interested in hockey are not always prepared for the pressures of trying to learn both skating and hockey skills at the same time. Give them a head start with us.

The Woodbine Winter Skating Club is a **NON-PROFIT** local community club that has been offering young skaters the opportunity to learn the basic skating skills for over 24 years. Once your child has learned to skate, they then can go on to competing in Figure Skating, Hockey or even recreational skating.

Many of the young skaters who have taken our programs have gone on to be successful in competitive figure skating and all levels of hockey. Many of local schools introduce skating in the winter months. Our program will prepare your child for this introduction or pick up where they left off last year.

The "Learn to Skate" program is designed by Skate Canada and taught by NCCP certified Professional coaches. The program is divided into six stages with each stage teaching various skating disciplines. All efforts are maintained to keep the **Student to Instructor ratio at 6 to 1.**

PAYMENT:

CLUB RULES

1. Skating helmets, Hockey helmets and gloves/mittens must be worn by Canskate up to Stages 4 (**No bicycle helmets allowed**)
2. It is strongly recommended that parents not leave the arena during sessions without designating another parent as monitor.
3. All skaters are encouraged to use the assigned dressing rooms for changing and putting on skates.
4. No parents or non-member skaters are allowed on the ice during the "Learn to Skate" or Canskate programs.
5. Advanced Skaters - Proper skating attire is required.
